

The event was a great success as there were student teams from colleges across Kerala. The first three teams were awarded cash prizes.






INSPERIA 1.0






ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING(AGM)-2022

DATE: 19th November 2021 **Venue:** Main Seminar Hall



DATE: 30th November 2021 VENUE: Seminar Hall



Date: 5 March 2022




Around 70 Students attended the meet, making the event a success.



JAM- JUST A MINUTE


Date of event:-19/06/2022 Platform:-Google Meet
